What We Do

Seeking to glorify God and proclaim the gospel of Christ through healing ministry, MBF:

- **Supports** long-term PC(USA) health-related mission workers.
- **Raises** financial support for partner churches/ health-related ministries
- **Obtains and administers** government grants for hospital and nursing school construction and renovation.
- **Ships** medical supplies and equipment to overseas partner institutions.
- **Provides** resources, news and mission education to churches and individuals to develop and strengthen mission partnerships.
- **Provides** accountability for funds received as well as for funds disbursed to partners.

Program Areas

Where Most Needed – the cause offering the greatest flexibility for using funds when and where they are most needed.

Missionary Support – salary support and expenses for PC(USA) healthcare mission workers.

Community Health & Development – health-related programs aimed at disease prevention and long-term health development work for whole communities.

Indigenous Healthcare Training – training programs and nursing schools to address the shortage of skilled healthcare staff in hospitals and rural clinics.

Women & Children's Health – programs including maternity care, well baby and infant healthcare, treatment minimizing HIV transmission to newborns, and care for vulnerable children at community based child care centers.

HIV/AIDS – education and testing to minimize the spread of HIV, and treatment to enhance the quality of life for AIDS victims.

Diseases of Poverty – programs for the prevention and treatment of malaria, tuberculosis and HIV/AIDS.

Medical Supplies & Equipment – shipping of donated supplies, medicine and equipment for hospitals or clinics (purchase of high priority supplies or equipment when otherwise not available).

Hospital & Clinic Facilities – construction, renovation, maintenance and operational support for hospitals and clinics.

Charity / Curative Care – medical care for patients who cannot afford to pay for services.
